**ISLE OF WIGHT FESTIVAL** - The award winning music Festival is steeped in history and famed for mixing iconic legendary artists with the hottest up and coming acts. The 2019 festival gets under way on 13th until 16th June and the headliners so far are Noel Gallaghers High Flying Birds, George Ezra, Biffy Clyro, Lilly Allen, Madness, Jess Glynne, Rick Astley and many more!

**COWES WEEK** - one of the Island's busiest weeks, when 8,500 competitors and more than 100,000 spectators coverage on Cowes for the largest sailing regattas in the world. 10th to 17th August 2019 - ending with a fabulous firework display on the Friday night!

**SHANKLIN REGATTA** - coinciding with Shanklin's carnival week, the towns regatta features many free afternoon events and races on the beach and esplanade finished with a spectacular firework display. Carnivals are on 7th and 10th August with the regatta normally the following Thursday.

**GARLIC FESTIVAL** - 17th - 18th August - based near Newchurch, arrive hungry to this event so you can try all the garlic flavoured goodies. From hot crusty bread to mussels, lamb, beer and even ice cream!

**JACK UP THE SUMMER** - 10th - 11th August at North Fairlee Farm in Newport - a superb family friendly festival which continues to go from strength to strength with this years acts Nick Heyward, East 17, 911, Republica and many more

**ISLE OF WIGHT SCOOTER RALLY** - Every August Bank Holiday thousands of scooter enthusiasts from all over the world descend on the Island to celebrate iconic Italian design and British youth culture.

**WALK THE WIGHT** - This is the largest sponsored walk in the South - it returns in 2019 for its 29th year. A spectacular 26-mile walk across the breadth of the Island attracts thousands of people annually - taking place on 12th May

**CLASSIC BEER, BUSES AND WALKS** - The Islandwide event attracts up to 100 Classic Buses to the island, running a free network of bus services connecting up to 100 hostelrys serving Real Ales - 12th and 13th October.
